

Creating The Midway Grouping.



Everyone was asked to bring something such as gauze, soil, stones, Wild Olive, dressing stone.

The pot was donated by Jonathan and Denise.

The gauze was placed in the soil with a layer of sand to anchor the rocks.



Rocks were then placed, starting with biggest with the same striations and placing the highest to the smallest. Rocks were donated and placed by Ina, Dave and Johnny B.



The main focal tree, donated by John Barnard was place. Note how it flows to the side of the planting.



The secondary and tertiary trees were then placed to the back of the primary tree.

Note how the silhouette flows between tree one and two.

The three smaller grouping of trees was placed to the right of the main trees. Note how they flow away from the main tree and how the silhouette flows. Rocks were being placed and removed as suggested by the audience.
